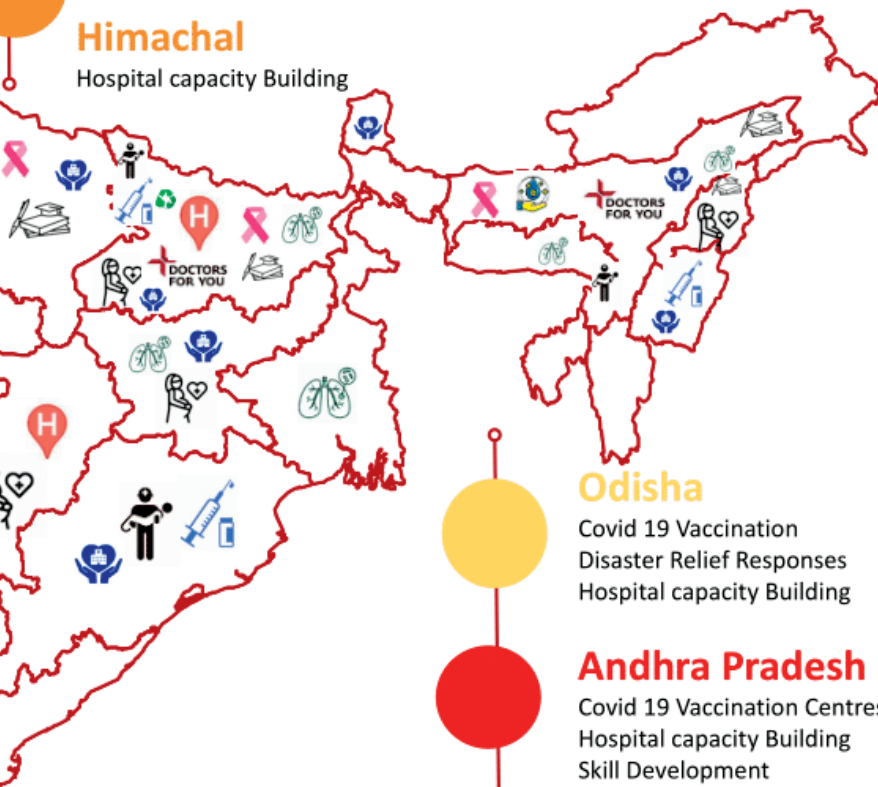

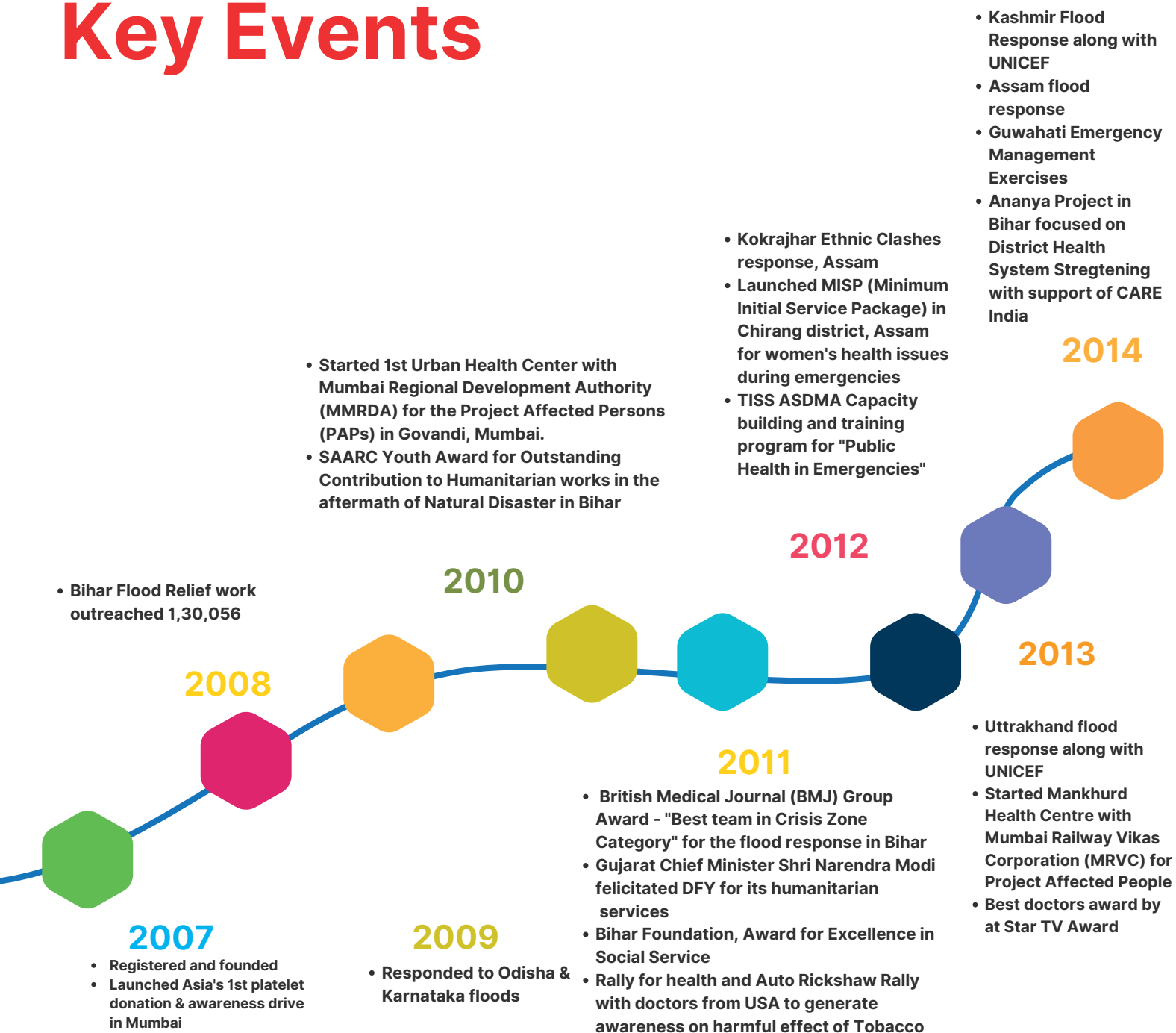

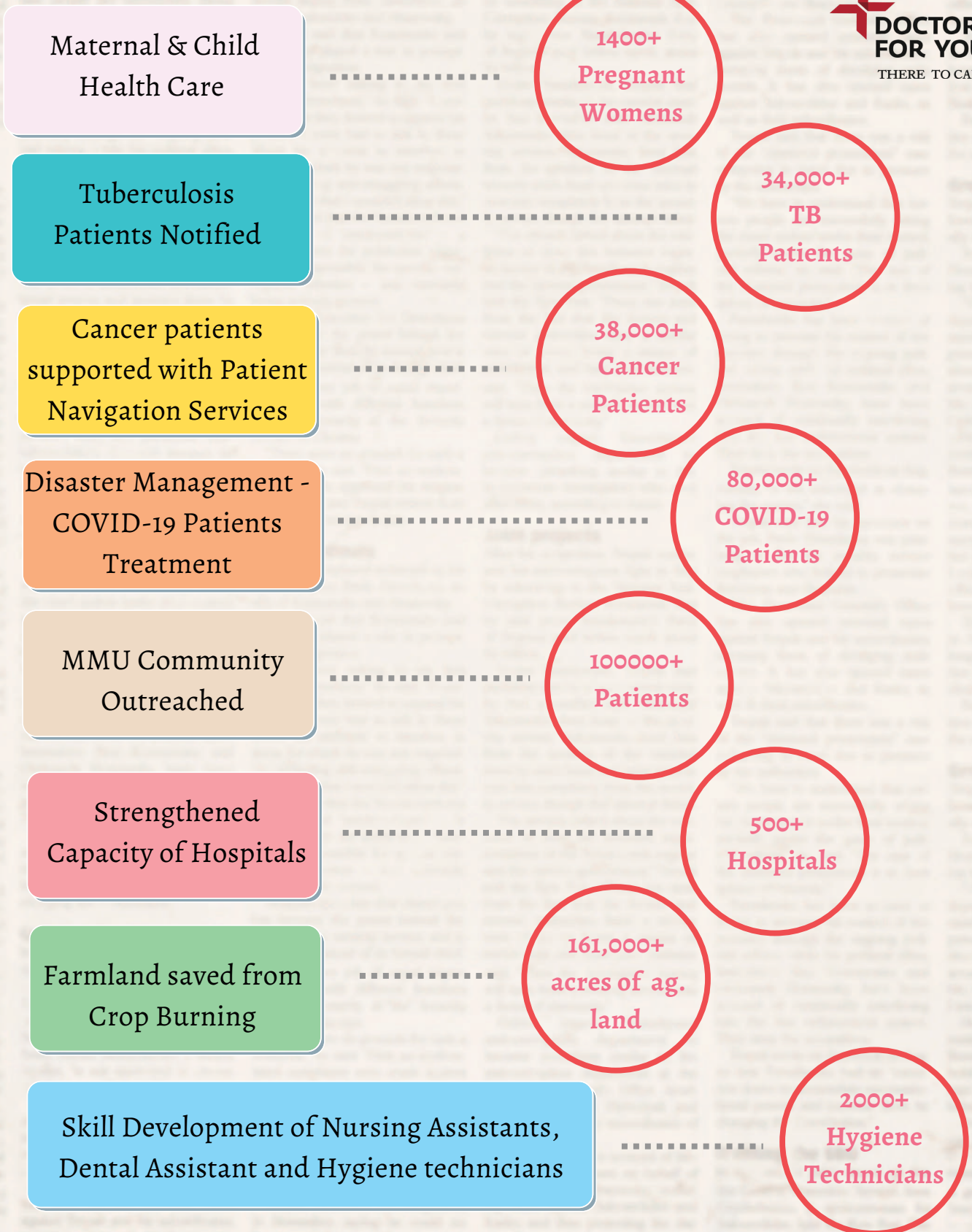

MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH CARE

REDUCING MATERNAL & CHILD MORTALITY IN RURAL, URBAN & TRIBAL SETTINGS

At least 200 million children living in developing countries fail to meet their developmental potential. Along with undernutrition, concomitant influences of infectious disease, environmental hazards, and societal and household violence, all contribute to this loss of potential. If the Pregnant mother and child is deprived of proper nutrition during this time damage to the brain and body will be irreversible.

The first 1,000 days of life - the time spanning roughly between conception and one's second birthday - is a unique period of opportunity when the foundations of optimum health, growth, and neurodevelopment across the lifespan are established. Apart from physical growth, a human baby's brain development paves the way for her future level of intelligence and quality of life.

Doctors For You is working in Rural, Urban & Slum areas of 12 states of India. The hospital/Health Care Centre - OPD services and Mobile Medical Unit - Health Camp approach is used to reach out to the vulnerable populations and improve access to essential primary health care services.



1000 Days Program

1. Comprehensive antenatal and post-natal care services to pregnant women
2. Home-based newborn and young child care (HBNC) through nutritional support to malnourished pregnant mothers and children 0-2 years of age
3. Surgical Intervention
4. Malnutrition interventions for cases of Severe Acute Malnutrition and Moderate Acute Malnutrition
5. Immunization and deworming services to all pregnant women and children up to 2 years
6. Training of the AAA's (ASHA, ANM, and Anganwadi Workers) for Home-based management of newborn and young children, Infant and young child feeding practices, and promoting IYCF practices within the family of newborns
7. Contraceptive counseling to all the lactating and reproductive-age women during the intervention.
8. Creating awareness for water, sanitation, and hygiene practices

CANCER CARE

EARLY DETECTION OF CANCER AND PATIENT NAVIGATION SERVICES TO CANCER PATIENTS

India's cancer problem is called an epidemic or a tsunami. It is the second and fourth leading cause of adult deaths in urban and rural India, respectively. India's cancer incidence indicates more than 1.3 million (approx. 0.097% of the total population 1,38,00,04,378 - Globocan 2020) new patients are diagnosed with cancer and over 850,000 patients die of the disease annually.

Cancer mortality in India has doubled from 1990 to 2016. The reasons behind high incidence cases could be poor prognosis, low level of cancer awareness, late diagnosis, and the lack of or inequitable access to affordable curative services. Between one-third and one-half of all cancers are potentially preventable.

Survival rates for breast, uterine cervix, and oral cavity cancers are good, provided they are detected and treated in the early stages. Therefore, Doctors For You organises screening camps are organized to screen breast, oral, cervix, and other cancers in vulnerable populations.

Cancer project "Aastha" is a Patient Navigation support service to Cancer Hospitals. It envisions providing handholding support to Cancer Patients during their course of treatment and their caretakers through Help Desk Services. The help desk team also tracks that Cancer patients adhere and come for regular follow-ups; provides counseling support, emotional support, connects the needy ones with financial schemes of the government, etc.

Cancer Control and Prevention Program

1. Primary cancer prevention through the promotion of health and wellness and reduction of risks known to contribute to cancer development.
2. Secondary cancer prevention through screening camps at the community and health care facilities to detect cancer at the earliest possible stage, NCD cases, etc.
3. Tertiary cancer care through networks & referrals to Cancer Care Hospitals/Centres and is applied to those individuals who have already been diagnosed with malignancy.
4. Patient Navigation Services for Cancer Patients through helpdesk at Cancer Institutes/Hospitals and supporting Cancer patients during treatment through various schemes and sponsorships

TUBERCULOSIS

TB ELIMINATION & IMPROVING ADHERENCE TO TB TREATMENT

Worldwide, TB is one of the top 10 causes of death and the leading cause of death from a single infectious agent (ranking above HIV/AIDS) despite being preventable and curable. India has more than 27% of the world's burden of both TB and drug-resistant TB as per the Global TB report 2020 with an estimated incidence of 26.9 lakh cases in 2019 as per WHO. As per the first National Drug Resistant Survey, 28% of TB patients were resistant to any drugs.

India is committed to end TB by 2025, five years ahead of SDG. To reach this goal in addition to strong political advocacy, there has been a massive expansion of the diagnostic network of laboratories, availability of new drugs, shorter regimens, decentralized treatment services, and improved drug logistics management.

Doctors For You aims to eliminate TB by improving adherence to treatment through TB notifications, free drugs for notified TB patients and extend adherence support to patients diagnosed and treated in the private sector under PPSA. Doctors For You fully covers 16 districts across Bihar, Assam, and Maharashtra. 15 team members work cordially in each district in different capacities and roles (Incharge, Coordinator, Field Officers, Hub Agents, Treatment Coordinators, Lab Technicians, etc).

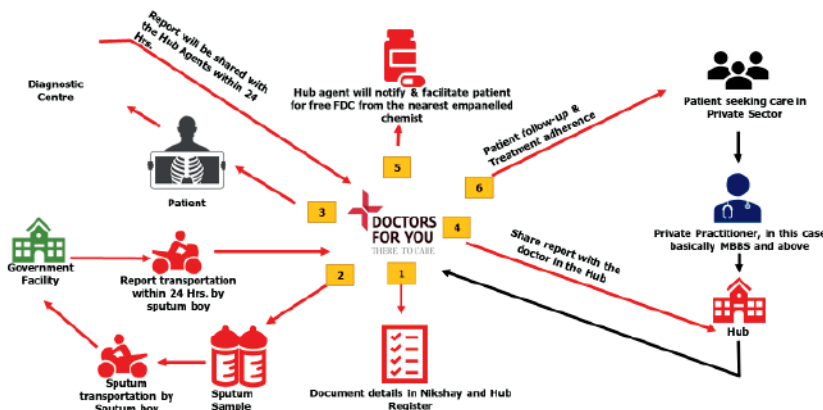
Patient-Provider Support Agency (PPSA)

IMPROVING SKILL & QUALITY OF LIFE

Today the world has more educated young people than ever before. Emerging insight to the Fourth Industrial Revolution suggests a mismatch of today's skills with the job opportunities of tomorrow.

Health services and hospitality sectors are one of the fundamental sectors of society and the economy. According to the Niti Aayog report (2021), India's healthcare industry is 5th largest employer and has been registering a 22% Compound Annual Growth Rate, since 2016.

Through TVET program of Doctors For You, 49,000+ candidates are enabled in skills of Hygiene Technicians and 300+ as Nursing Assistants & Dental Assistants (2015-2021). More than 80% of the registered candidates complete the TVET courses and around 70% of the candidates are placed, within the tenure of completing their courses.

During COVID-19 pandemic, doctors, nurses, and other staff have been trained in various capacities. From managing mild patients in a Covid care setting to taking care of critical patients in ICU. Nursing Orderlies were given hands-on training on managing, handling, and replacing oxygen concentrators & cylinders for patients on oxygen support and comforting the patients through empathetic behavior by the technical team, experts, doctors, and supervisor. Capacity-building exercises for Housekeeping staff were done on maintaining hygienic conditions at CCC, sanitizing, disinfecting the area regularly, and managing Bio-medical waste. Through the training and capacity-building exercises, we have been able to facilitate positive and constructive interaction with patients and have given them a feel of extended family culture.

Biomass Management

Biomass Management Project” aims to reduce crop burning in the state of Punjab and Haryana. 17565 farmers from 2 states (Punjab and Haryana), 5 districts (Patiala, Sangrur, and Taran Taran from Punjab and Rohtak & Jhajjar form Haryana), 7 blocks (Patiala, Nabha, Sangrur, Taran Taran, Gandiwind form Punjab and Rohtak & Jhajjar from Haryana) are covered under the ongoing project of biomass management. With the support of 35 Farmers' cooperative societies and as an outcome of community mobilization for change, Doctors For You prevented crop residue from burning in 83,000 acres of farmland in 115 villages of the states Punjab and Haryana by 2021. Technical handholding support and capacity building on the use of CRM machinery is facilitated by Punjab Agriculture University. Government monitoring supported with fire counts and law enforcement on the prohibition of crop residue burning

WASH & IPC Provisions in HCFs

WASH project emphasized on Strengthening Water, Sanitation, Hygiene (WASH) and Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) provisions in Healthcare Facilities with active engagement of key stakeholders in 77 health care facilities across 4 districts of Bihar. The implementation process has followed a series of key facilitating activities including conducting a pre-assessment using an android app-based application, analyzing the collected data, preparing a Gap Action Plan, training and capacity building of HCF functionaries, and critical WASH supplies, and the SBCC material, and periodic monitoring of HCFs. Periodic monitoring of the HCFs was based on WASH Assessment Checklist for Healthcare Facilities Both offline and online monitoring systems are used. In few states, DFY constructed Toilets in disaster affected areas and also to ensure WASH facilities to the community people.

India has a vast network of public health care infrastructure but inadequate physical infrastructure, equipment, drugs, manpower, and other logistical supplies impede quality health services.

Strengthening the government with infrastructure, Doctors For You has supported Primary Health Centre (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District hospitals by providing medical equipment, constructing of maternal & child health centres, setting up machinery for diagnostic services, refurbishing Command Centres at the district level, etc. DFY has donated more than 2,000 oxygen concentrators, 27 oxygen plants, 50 ventilators, 500 para monitors, 50 BiPAP machines, approx. 45 ambulances, genome laboratory machines, X-ray Machines, USG machines, Echo machines, CT scanners, Lab equipment support and strengthened support by providing computers, printers & Laptops.

MAKESHIFT HOSPITALS & HOME BASED CARE FOR COVID-19 PATIENTS

COVID-19 has been a global public health emergency. The World Health Organization declared COVID-19 as a pandemic on March 11, 2020. Global estimates of COVID-19 suggest that India is second-highest in the number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 infections and third-highest in the number of deaths due to COVID-19. In India, 40 million confirmed cases of COVID-19 are reported and 5 lakhs+ people have succumbed to death due to COVID-19.

Given the surge in COVID-19 cases across India, public health infrastructure was overburdened. Shortage of oxygen supply, beds with ventilators, essential medicines, lack of resources, anxiety, fear among people, etc have aggravated the COVID crisis. DFY played a major role in delivering healthcare services to vulnerable communities and providing capacity-building training, and emergency medical aid to the people during COVID-19.

Doctors For You partnered with state governments, District Disaster Management Authorities, and Corporate to set up Dedicated Covid Care Centers (DCHCs) or by making makeshift Covid Care Centers (CCC) across many states of India. DFY took the responsibility of managing Covid Care Centres by recruiting human resources such as doctors, nurses, and admin staff in large numbers to handle the ongoing crises. With the help of our trained doctors and nursing staff, these CCCs and DCHCs treated mild to moderate symptomatic Covid patients following ICMR/AIIMS disease management guidelines. Each COVID-19 Care hospital was connected with tertiary care hospital to admit patients in need of ICU care. The continuum of care approach is applied by transferring critically ill patients to tertiary care hospitals.

Combating COVID -19 is a race of human being against time to survive against a virus infection. Following Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB) and getting vaccinated are the chief defense mechanism against COVID-19. India began COVID-19 Vaccination Mission to fully vaccinate its population against Covid in the month of January 2021. The first vaccine was injected on 16th January, 2021.

India sustains a staggering 17.7% (1.39 billion) of the world's population. By the third week of October 2021, India has achieved the milestone of vaccinating 1 billion people. However, the large disparity in the district-wise coverage in rural areas & tribal-dominated blocks compared to urban or non-tribal areas became an imminent challenge. The shortage of vaccines and various myths regarding vaccines, and lack of awareness also contributed to the low vaccination coverage rate in India. Efforts are being laid by the Government and Non - Government agencies to expand the scope and pace of the vaccination drive, regularly.

Doctors For You (DFY) in collaboration with the Government of India/ Ministry/ State/ District authorities and its valuable CSR Partners has led the Vaccination to drive through its Vaccination Centre and disseminating information to rule out hesitancy among masses over Covid 19 Vaccines. In this endeavor, Covid 19 Vaccines and some logistic support are provided by the State or District Administration and Human resources - a team of Doctors, Nurses, and supporting staff is recruited, trained, and mobilized by the Doctors For You. The vaccination program is implemented in a staggered manner based on risk and epidemiological considerations. Apart from Human resource support, DFY managed the Data and overall functioning of the allotted vaccination centers.

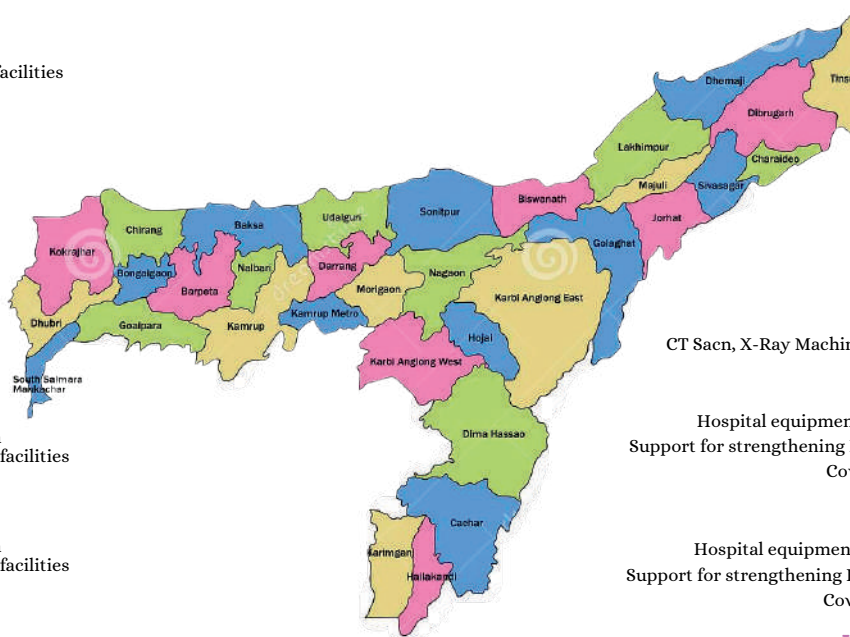

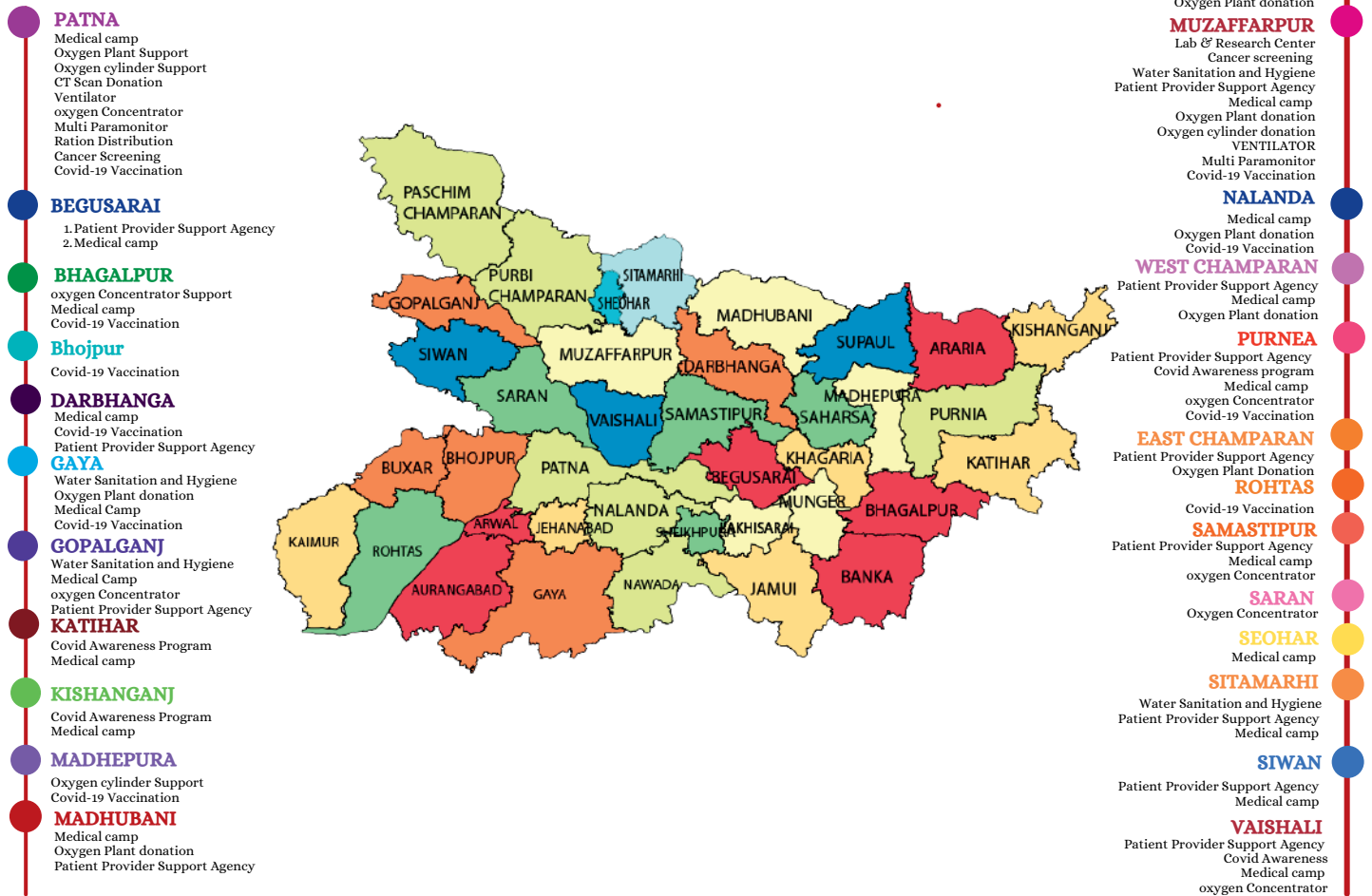

Vistex hospital is a 100 bedded hospital located in Masarhi, Fatuha block of Patna district, Bihar. The hospital is equipped to attend patients in OPD & IPD, emergency care or casualty section, I.C.U, O.T, Surgery, Labor room, Dental Care, Physiotherapy, Diagnostics - CT Scan and Radiology units, training hall for health care workers, Immunization room, Lab & sample collection Unit, Nutrition Rehabilitation - CMAM unit, Pharmacy, etc. The hospital has a daily OPD turnout of approx. 70-80 patients and attends to surgery patients once a week.

COVID-19 RURAL HOSPITAL

Second wave of COVID-19 was on peak in the month of April, 2021. It was difficult for patients to get oxygenated beds in hospitals. Doctors For You in partnership with Bihar Government and with our CSR Partners started one COVID-19 Care Centre at Vistex Hospital and another Dedicated COVID-Care Hospital was developed by converting a sports complex into makeshift hospital dedicated for the treatment of mild and moderate symptomatic patients of the COVID-19. The established hospital had 100 oxygenated beds including 10-bed HDU at Vistex Hospital, Masarhi, Bihar and DCHC Patliputra Sports Complex at Patna, Bihar. Created COVID-19 facilities were also revived in the Omicron lead third wave of COVID-19 and made functional for COVID-19 patients in need of hospitalisation.

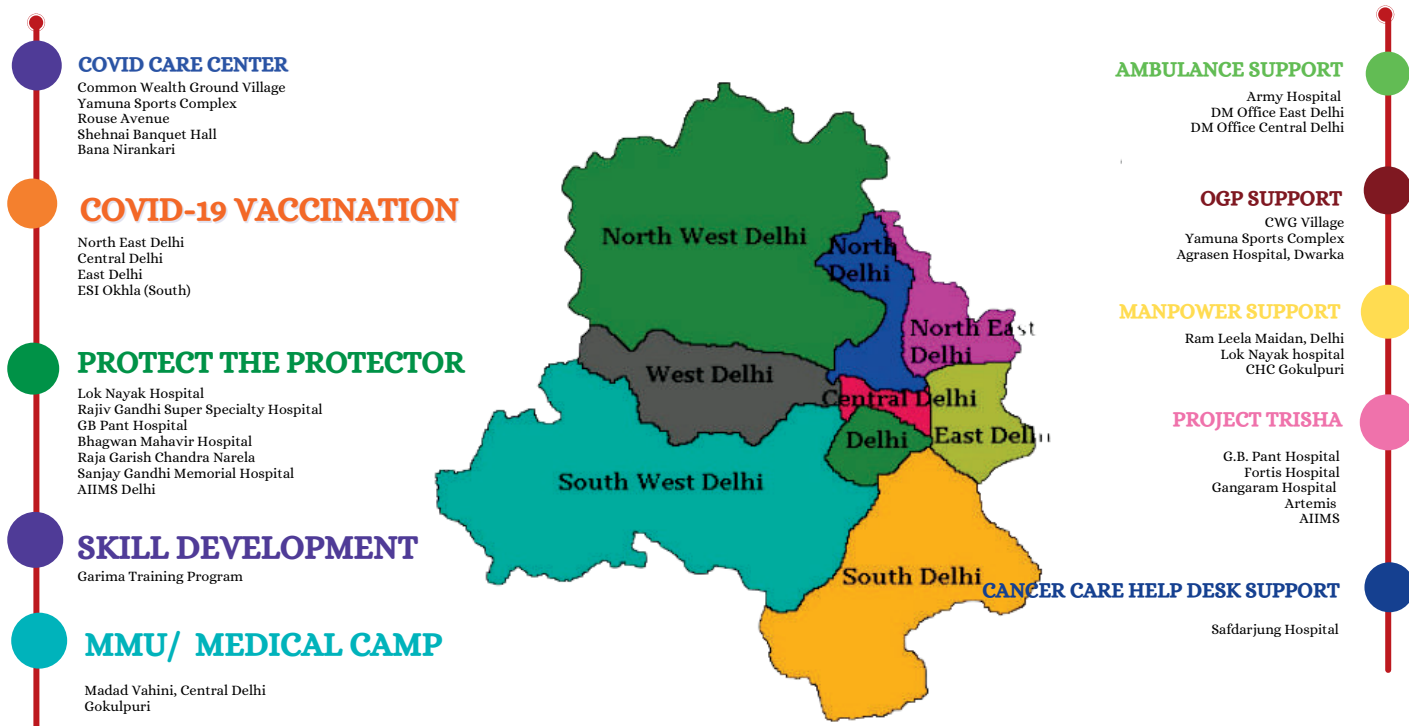

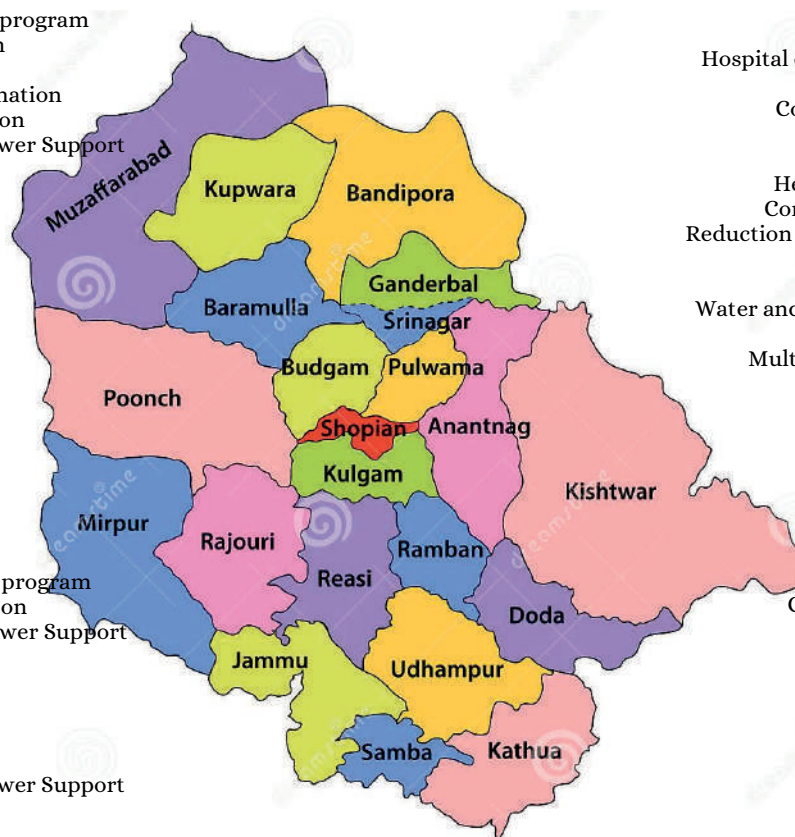

RURAL & URBAN HOSPITALS

Primary and Secondary Health Care Support

DFY is working in rural areas of all four blocks (Pampore, Tral, Pulwama and Rajpora) of the Pulwama district.

- Human resource support (2 medical and 2 paramedical staff) is provided to PHC Rahmoo, PHC Abhama, PHC Pinglena, and PHC Achan which runs through the Directorate Of Health Services Kashmir.
- In District Pulwama, DFY started the MCH program under the rural project at PHC Rahmoo, Rajpora block. Females, especially pregnant women were facing lots of challenges as only male doctors were available on duties.
- DFY took an active step to arrange for gynecologists to attend to pregnant women, adolescents, etc.
- Nursing Staff, Nursing assistant, and once a week Doctor is present at PHCs,
- OPD, RAT Testing, immunization, Albendazole and Vitamin A Distribution, etc services are strengthened at PHC.
- Organizing awareness programs, vaccination/immunization support, MMU, and special camps are organized through health care facilities.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH



Mobile Medical Unit (MMU)

- Mobile Medical Units have been very helpful for elderly, who had difficulty seeking services of hospitals in harsh winter when the temperature drops to subzero level.
- MMUs are conducted in Far-flung and Tribal areas of all the Four Blocks (Pampore, Tral, Pulwama and Rajpora) of Pulwama. Especially in Sangerwani, Abhama and Satoora areas because these are hilly areas, occupation is mostly cattle grazing and Transport facility is almost negligible due to hilly area.
- Health camps are being held at Anganwadi centers, schools, local community centers, etc

Special Health Camps

- Gynaecology Health Camp - ANC checkups, anemic screening, nutritional counseling, Personal Hygiene, IYCF counseling, immunization, screening for malnutrition, etc

INTEGRATED APPROACH TO DIGITALLY ENABLED IMNCI CARE



An Integrated Approach to Digitally Enabled IMNCI Care (e-IMNCI) project is a prototype to improve clinical practices of the primary level health service providers (ANMs and MOs) to deliver IMNCI services.

An Android-based application guides Health Care Workers (HCWs) through the IMNCI algorithm from the clinical assessment of the child, classification, treatment prescription, referral and counselling. 80 (ANMs and Medical Officers) are trained to use mobile based applications - e-IMNCI in Ranchi district of Jharkhand.

Given the success of the Phase-1 of this project in Jharkhand, project is scaled up to an additional 45 health facilities and 80 HCWs in Jharkhand.

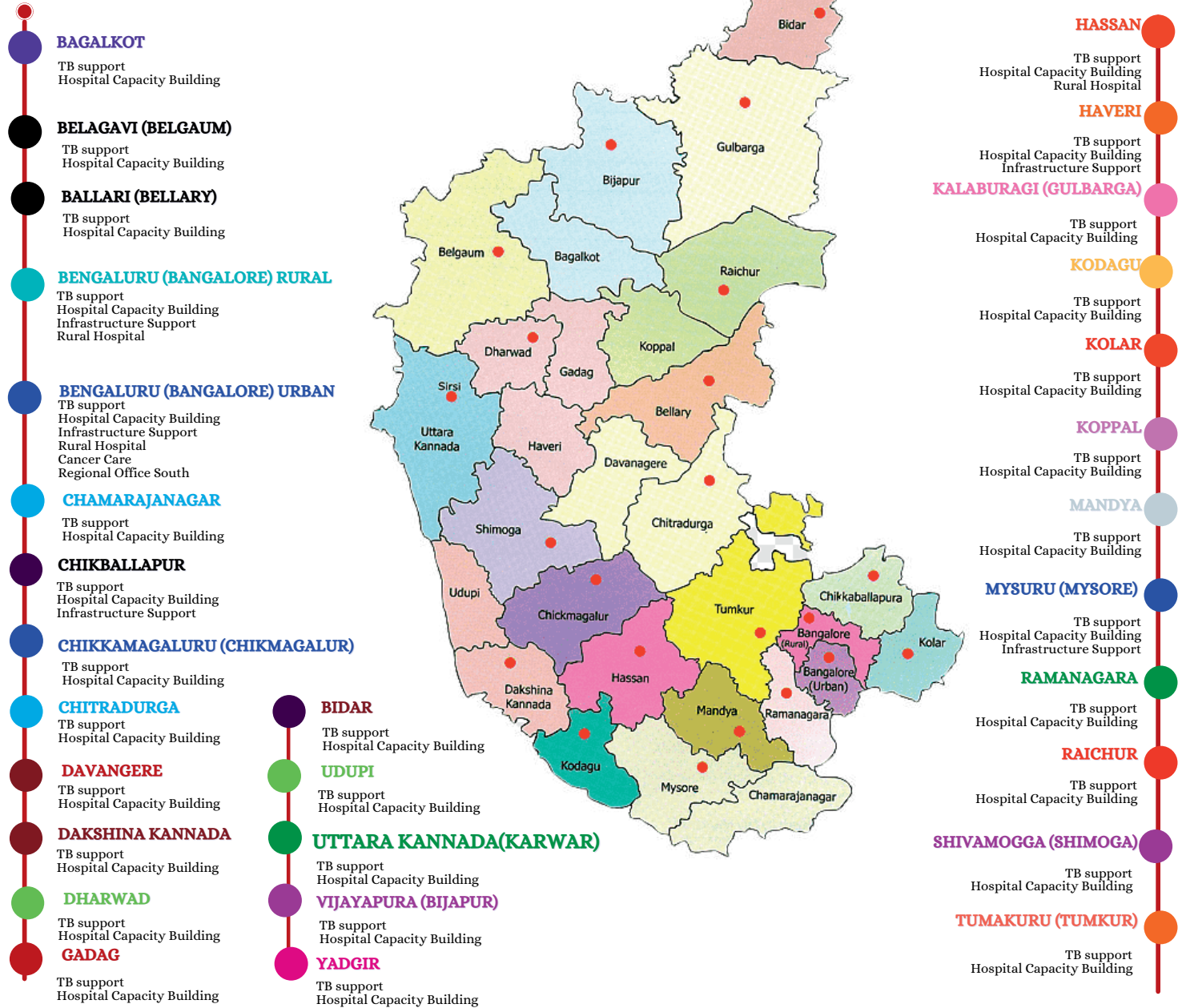

KPCL Yelahanka Hospital, Bangalore

DFY in collaboration with CSR partners & Govt constructed a 100 bedded hospital with 10 ICUs & 20 HDUs in a record-breaking time of 21 days which is now completely managed by DFY, serving the entire population of Bangalore (12,765,000) on a Non-Profit basis.

In this Hospital, currently, OPD, IPD, Lab, Physiotherapy, Dental, COVID Vaccination, and MMU camps (in which MCH, NCD, Cancer screening) is being conducted. During the Second & Third wave of COVID, this hospital served as DCHC where patients were managed and discharged with no fatalities.

The hospital is situated at a location that it covers the major slum and rural populations of Bangalore, Urban District, and also can serve as a referral hospital for the taluk of Bangalore Rural district.

Konanuru Health Care Center, Hassan

DFY supported the hospital by managing the Covid patients during the second & Third-wave following which Covid Vaccination & Covid testing, MMU camps, and OPD & IPD services were also conducted. This hospital not only increased the bed availability but also helped in reducing the workload of govt. hospitals. The hospital covers 396,166 population.

Make Shift Hospital Doddaballapur, Bangalore Rural

45 bedded hospital with 2 ICU blocks containing 12 ICU beds and is now being managed by DFY in collaboration with Govt. Currently, this hospital is running OPD, IPD, ICU services, MMU Camps, and COVID-19 Vaccination. This hospital serves as an extension of Doddaballapur Taluk Hospital. For all the PHCs and UPHCs in the taluk, this is the only referral center. This hospital was initially operated for Covid where patients were managed in the Second and Third-wave of Covid which was a boon for the population of the taluk.

PHC Hattimattur Upgradation

Hattimattur, a densely populated village in Haveri district, has a 30-year-old PHC which is not safe to use and has the hazard of a leaking roof. So, a new block for the MCH services is being constructed with a top-of-the-line OT unit, ICU, Labor room, Neonate Unit, and Labor ward.

Victoria Hospital ICU Upgradation

Victoria Hospital, affiliated with BMCRI, is the tertiary care center for the entire state of Karnataka. Patients not only from the state but also from entire south India are referred here for tertiary treatment. To tackle the patient load 4 wards of the hospital were upgraded to an ICU with infrastructural support.

KPCL Yelahanka Hospital

A 100 bedded hospital with 10 ICU and 20 HDUs was constructed in collaboration with CSR partners in a 3500sq. ft. area to fulfill the health care needs in the Yelahanka region and to serve as a tertiary referral center to both Bangalore Urban and Bangalore Rural districts

SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Soap For Hope

- In the Regional office, Soap is being made from the soaps collected from hotels and distributed free of cost to Hospitals and Schools.

Hygiene Technician Skill Training

- In Karnataka, Hygiene Technician training is conducted for the underprivileged community. Once the 5 day training program is completed DFY enables them with placement at various organisations of hospitality or health sector.

TRAINING AND RESEARCH

The training was given to the staff during the COVID-19 vaccination program regarding AEFI and BMW. The training was given to the staff regarding Vitamin A and Albendazole as per MOHFW guidelines.

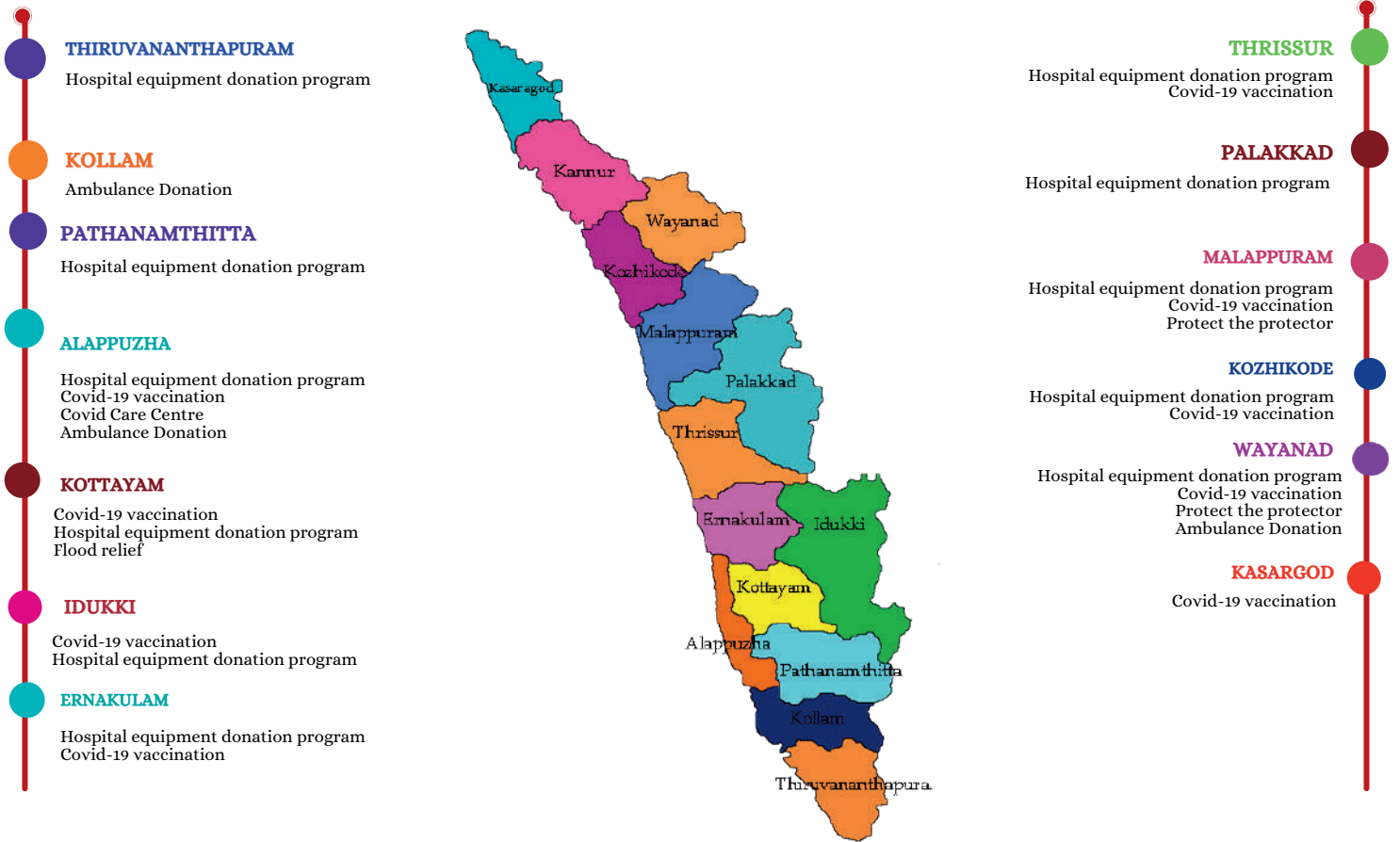

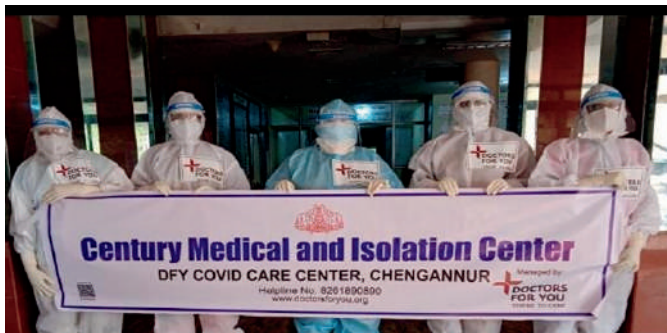


COVID CARE CENTRES

As the cases started to rise during the third wave of COVID-19, Doctors For You with the support of District administration Alappuzha set up a Covid Care Centre in Chengannur, Alappuzha on 27th January 2022. There were 45 staff from Doctors For You including staff nurses, assistant nurses, house keepers, HR and admin department.

With the tremendous effort of Doctors For You and DMO Team (Alappuzha), we could take care of the lives of patients at our COVID-19 Care Center (Century Hospital, Chengannur). There were a total 117 patients (Discharged patients 97, Transferred patients from triage 10 and hospital 9 and 1 was brought dead).

The entire staff was very energetic and cooperative in patient care. Many patients were supported with O2 (B type 23 & D type 35 oxygen cylinders). Food and water was supplied by the Chengannur block. The team also conducted exercises and other recreational activities for the patients.



COVID-19 VACCINATION

With the request of Alappuzha Panchayat, Doctors For You and the Panchayat signed an MOU that DFY would start providing HR support from June 2021 onwards.

In the beginning, it provided with 5 teams which further expanded to 21 teams during the second wave. Each team consisted of 1 Doctor, 2 Staff Nurse, 2 Assistant Nurse and 2 Data Entry Operator.

The teams were placed in major Hospitals like, Alappuzha General Hospital, Mavelikara District Hospital, Chengannur District Hospital, Kayamkulam Taluk Hospital, Cherthala Taluk Hospital.

11 districts - Alapuzha, Wayanad, Kottayam, Kasargod, Adimali, Kochi, Malapuram, Nilambur, Perinthalmanna, Manjeri, Tirur. Total number of doses Administered are across 11 district of Kerala are 927629 of Covid Vaccine.

HOSPITAL CAPACITY BUILDING

During the second wave of the COVID-19 the vulnerabilities of the health system came into light when hospitals ran short of beds, oxygen supply and other medical essentials. DFY came forward to strengthen the health infrastructure of government hospitals in Kerala by providing essential medical and diagnostic equipments.

- Medical equipment's (Ventilators, X-Ray machine, ICU Beds, Ambulances, etc) to various health care facilities in 12 districts
- 326 oxygen concentrators in 12 districts
- 4 oxygen generation plants have been set up of which 3 are in Alappuzha district and 1 in Pathanamthitta district.

FLOOD RESPONSE

In October 2021, Kerala was hit by major flooding and landslides affecting the central districts of Kottayam and Idukki. A team of 7 members including a Coordinator, a Doctor, 2 Vaccinators, 2 Nursing Assistants, and a Data Entry Operator from the DFY Kottayam Mobile Unit were deployed to the landslide-stricken area at Kootikkal, Munadakayam in Kottayam district to strengthen the rescue efforts.

The DFY team reached the site to help with the rescue operation and provided medical relief to the affected population. The team provided medical care to the victims. Rapid Antigen Testing camps were set up to ramp up COVID testing in the region.

As a part of the post-disaster response, our mobile vaccination teams conducted multiple vaccination camps to provide COVID-19 vaccination to the affected population.

RURAL HEALTH CARE

Dindori is a tribal district of Madhya Pradesh which is 140 Km away from Jabalpur. Because the healthcare services at District Hospital Dindori are inadequate, the CMHO decided to strengthen these services. Thus, CMHO has requested DFY for support by providing handholding support and critical care management training.

On the 7th of February 2022, the Doctors For You team landed in DH Dindori. The DFY team began assessment of the ICU, PICU, and HDU set up. Based on DFY report CMHO and CS, promptly delivered all of the necessary equipment and consumables for the ICU. DFY set up the ICU in 2 days and made it fully functional. Trained health professional in critical care management and provided handholding support.

The work of the DFY team has been recognized by both the CMHO and the CS. It has resulted in significant changes in Dindori's healthcare.

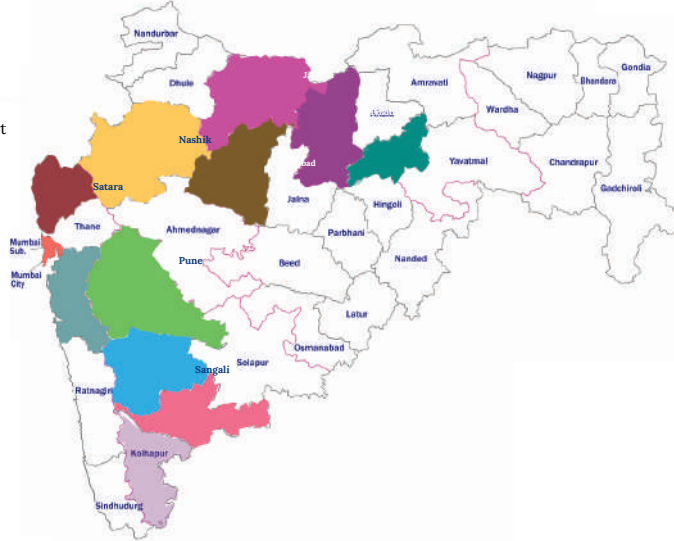

Teams of Doctors with paramedical staff were sent as MMUs in orphanages, old age homes & slum areas to help those who are in need of medical attention. Patients are screened for diabetes, hypertension, cancer etc.

Entire community of over 1 lakh was screened and given medications. Patients in need of care and follow up were referred to higher centers.
