## **Psychological Care and** Support - Kerala

-Supported by Tata Community Initiatives Trust



The Tata Community Initiatives Trust (TCIT) has formally agreed to support Doctors For You (DFY) in delivering psychosocial care and support to individuals and families affected by recent floods and landslides in Wayanad, Kerala. The project focuses on providing mental health counseling to landslide survivors, volunteers from Aapda Mitra, response agencies such as health and police departments, all of whom are grappling with trauma. Additionally, the initiative will train school teachers and counselors to support children affected by the disaster, aiming to bolster resilience across four blocks: Kalpetta, Panamaram, Sulthan Bathery, and Mananthavady.

## New Projects in Sept, 2024

### Sampoornata Abhiyan - NITI Aayog





Doctors For You (DFY) is proud to partner with NITI Aayog for the Sampoornata Abhiyaan under the Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP). This 3-month initiative targets healthcare improvements in underserved regions, focusing on maternal and child health and non-communicable disease prevention. Key efforts include boosting early Antenatal Care (ANC) registrations, ensuring supplementary nutrition for pregnant women, increasing child immunization rates, and expanding screenings for diabetes and hypertension. In Phase 1, the campaign covered 7 states, 23 aspirational districts, and 12 aspirational blocks, benefiting over 26,000 individuals. DFY and NITI Aayog aim to bring transformative change to India's most vulnerable communities.

## **DFY Takes a Step Forward in Breast**

### **Cancer Prevention**

Doctors For You (DFY) is thrilled to announce the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with AstraZeneca at Army Hospital (Research and Referral), Delhi Cantt, to launch a Breast Cancer Screening Program. This initiative focuses on promoting early detection and timely intervention for breast cancer.

The program will feature awareness sessions, distribution of prescreening questionnaires, and Clinical Breast Examinations (CBE), along with mammography appointments for those requiring further assessment. A dedicated team of healthcare professionals, including doctors, nurses, and radiologists, will provide comprehensive care throughout the initiative.

In the coming months, mammography vans will be mobilized to extend essential screening services to women, enhancing accessibility and ensuring more people receive timely, life-saving screenings.

#### Poshan Maah 2024



DFY actively contributed to Maah 2024 Poshan campaign, conducting 45+ sessions and benefiting over 2,300 individuals. In Gautam Budh Nagar, nutrition camps focused balanced diets and maternal nutrition. In Jammu & Kashmir, DFY reached 65 beneficiaries through nutritional counseling and growth monitoring at Anganwadi centers. In West Bengal, the Iron Shakti Project engaged 932 people with puppet shows and counseling. In Delhi, anemia awareness sessions and HB testing impacted 4,429 individuals, while in Mumbai, DFY conducted anemia screenings and nutrition counseling for pregnant women, promoting early detection and treatment.

## CASE STUDY 1 Timely Intervention Aids in the Recovery of 2.5-Year-Old Burn Patient: ZHT, Mandala

A 2.5-year-old patient named Naira was brought to ZHT Mandala Health Centre by her mother after accidentally sustaining burns from hot tea. The burns affected her left buttocks and left leg. The medical team at ZHT Mandala Health Centre promptly cleaned and dressed the wounds. Naira was administered a tetanus toxoid injection, and treatment with antibiotics and painkillers was initiated. After four days, Naira's condition improved significantly. She continues to receive ongoing care at ZHT Mandala Health Centre.

Doctors For You team visited the Achegoza village for assessment of ANC registrations and check ups to ensure achievement of 100% saturation in the block which is an aspirational block as per NITI Aayog. During our visit, it came to our notice that one lady is yet to register but lives in hilly area of Lassidaban which is not accessible by any vehicle so we tried to contact the Asha worker to reach out to the lady as early as possible and using our vehicle the patient was then brought to the Health and Wellness Center by road from where it became accessible. Therefore reaching out to people in far flung areas is quite difficult but we can establish people to people contact to establish links in such villages in which we succeeded.

### TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

**UNICEF GAVI Program Initiation - Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC)** 





In September 2024, Doctors For You (DFY) began implementing the UNICEF GAVI project in Pune Municipal Corporation, following the BRIDGE IPC training conducted in August. This training focused on Social Behavioral Change Communication (SBCC) and the Socio-Ecological Model, equipping staff with skills in interpersonal communication, community meetings, and mobilization. As part of the Zero Dose Implementation, DFY has undertaken several key activities, including recruiting skilled personnel, engaging stakeholders to align community efforts, and collecting baseline data to guide the project. These steps are vital to ensuring effective interventions for the targeted zero-dose populations.

**Disaster Management Training** 



Doctors For You (DFY) has initiated weekly training sessions aimed at empowering field staff in disaster management. The training covers essential topics to help mitigate challenges faced during field operations, such as effective data management and strategies for being both preventive and responsive in disaster situations.
